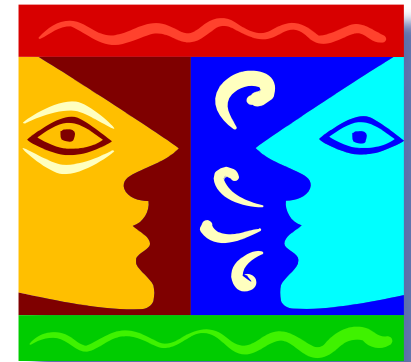

3. Alternative sober support groups, 12 Step groups and other groups are used as a way to maintain long-term sobriety.

COMPLETE CONFIDENTIALITY

In most cases, the cost of the whole program is not more than you would have as a co-payment with your insurance. Your name or any of your personal information will not be entered into any database.

Specialty Tracks ~ A Personal Touch

Chronic Relapsers Track

Clients that have been through treatment before may have special needs that require specific training to avoid future relapses. Relapse prevention is the main focus in this track.

Women's Track

Sometimes women have PTSD issues, relationships issues, parenting issues, and health issues. This track helps to address these issues and more.

Gay and Lesbian Track

Discussing relationship issues in a heterosexual setting may be stifling for some people. This track focuses on issues around sexuality and relationships.

Criminal Justice Track

Thinking Errors, Morals, Values, Ethics, and Responsibility are the focus of this track for those involved in the legal system.

OTHER SERVICES

Individual or Family Counseling

Ongoing therapy may be needed to deal with more sensitive issues.

Assessment Service

Recommendation to an appropriate level of care is given. A written report is provided to referral source.

Family Intervention Services

Structured program assists families with helping to get loved one to enter a treatment program.

Basic Chemical Dependency Education

This 8 week program is available for those who may be at high risk of developing the disease or have some minor problems as the result of substance abuse.

Anger Management

This is a structured program that utilizes exercises and discussion to cope with feelings of anger in healthy expression.
