### Providing limited *free and half scholarships* for intensive outpatient substance dependency treatment

**WHO:** New Direction's outpatient services are designed for those who are able to stay abstinent from drugs or alcohol between sessions, which are usually one to three times a week.

**WHAT:** **New Direction** employs a holistic, completely confidential treatment model designed to heal the whole person – spirit, mind and body.

Here's how the outreach program works: *New Direction makes seven treatment scholarships available at all times -- two free slots and five half-price slots.* Call for availability.

**WHEN:** The outreach program started in September, and will continue for the foreseeable future.

**WHERE:** New Direction Treatment Services, LLC, located at 1634 Central Pkwy

**WHY:** *“Chemical dependency is a growing problem in the Tri-State, and the new outreach program we started in September is our way of helping to impact this problem and give back to the community,”* said Donna Butler, a chemical dependency counselor and owner of New Direction.

**HOW:** Eligibility for the scholarship is determined case by case, and is based on the potential client's ability to pay. Eligibility is based on not just income, but also medical bills, family obligations, education expenses, temporary loss of income and other factors.
